

# **Colchester Club Championships 2019**

## **Level 4 License 4ER191197 & 4ER190460**

### **Braintree Swimming & Fitness Centre**

**Held under ASA Laws and Regulations and ASA Technical Rules of Racing and to the ASA Open Meet Licensing Criteria**

The competition is a level 4, licensed meet, held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules.

The competition is only open to members of Colchester Swimming Club.

The Promoter is Helen Stephens on behalf of Colchester Swimming Club.

**To enter:** All entries to be made through the club website via Swimfee Meet Entry System (<https://www.swimfee.com/>)

### **Who can enter?**

All current Club swimmers from the Academy top swimmers (with approval from Donna: Academy Manager) to Performance Plus and Masters Squad.

### **When to enter: NOTE THESE DATES CAREFULLY**

- The final closing date is Friday 7th September 2019.
- Late entries will not be permitted in any circumstances.

The Club Championship Sub Committee must agree all rule alterations.

### **What Competitions are there?**

- 50m all four strokes – Academy/Junior/Young Potential squads only.
- 100m all four strokes
- 400m Freestyle
- 200m & 400m Individual Medley
- 800m & 1500m Freestyle – No Academy or Junior squad swimmers

The pool is 25m and anti-wave devices will be in place. The AOE (Automatic Officiating Equipment) will be used when available.

Heats will be swum as mixed ages with swimmers seeded by entry times. Over the top starts will be used at the referee's discretion.

### **What events to enter:**

Academy may enter any events they are deemed suitable for by Academy Manager.

Senior Development may enter any events they qualify for in events list.

Junior & Young Potential should enter as a minimum: 50m events

You can also enter any other events that you feel capable of. If in any doubt, talk to your Lane Coach. Potential, Performance and Performance Plus squads should compete in at least: 3 x 100m events plus 1 x distance event: 400m, 800m or 1500m freestyle.

Youth Masters and Masters may enter any event in events list, except 50m.

## What times to submit?

Submit your best time for each event.

Juniors/Young Potential who does not have a time for an event should email Michelle: [chief.coach@colchesterswimming.com](mailto:chief.coach@colchesterswimming.com) for a time at least one week **IN ADVANCE**. It is the parents/swimmers responsibility to complete and submit the entry via Swimfee Meet Entry System (<https://www.swimfee.com/>) before the closing date **Friday 7th September 2019**.

Entries for distance events may be restricted at Coaches' discretion to swimmers closest to Essex Age Group Championship times.

**For all events, age is the age you will be on 31 December 2019**

## Fees

- £3.00 per event for: 50, 100, 400 and IM
- £4.00 per event for: 800m and 1500m
- PLUS £4 ADMIN FEE

**Please note that all swimmers are encouraged to enter as many races as they wish. To support the enthusiasm of the swimmer and to help family expenditure, entry costs will be capped at a maximum amount of £25.00. Irrespective of the number of events entered, you will not pay more than £25 for entries. You must then add your £4 administration fee, so a grand total of £29.**

**For smoother running of the events, please make every attempt to turn up for events you have entered.**

Refunds will only be given if: events are not run due to pool closures, if entries are restricted and at Coaches discretion.

## Photography

In order to comply with the Swim England's child protection policy and the conditions of the meet licence, all members should ensure they familiarise themselves with the Club's Photography Policy found on our website before the meet. There is not a requirement to register your own phone, tablet or camera at this meet. However, all photos should only be taken in accordance with our Photography Policy, to ensure we continue to safeguard all our members. The rules on photography apply to swimmers, coaches, team managers, officials and volunteers as well as spectators, and to the use of mobile phones, tablets or other image-capturing electronic devices as well as cameras. Note that no mobile phones are allowed on poolside and any photography in the changing rooms, toilets and showers is **absolutely forbidden** by both the club and the swimming pool management.

## Safety

All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at Braintree Swimming & Fitness Centre. Neither the promoter nor Colchester Swimming Club will be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during this meet.

## What happens next?

- Once entries have been processed, the final event schedule will be posted on [www.colchesterswimming.com](http://www.colchesterswimming.com) and the notice board.
- Swimmers may only swim on the dates and events allocated to them, even if different to those provisionally advised. No refunds will be given.
- A "signing-in" system will operate for each session.
- Swimmers must sign in before the stated time to be able to compete at that session.

Entries to the meet will be held on a computer and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information on computer, will be deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Personal data will be available for inspection during the Meet on application to the Promoter.

## How winners are selected:

All events are swum as 'heat declared winners'. That is, everyone swims the event in heats and the winners are decided from the times recorded for that swim. There are **NO** finals.

Manual reconciliation will be made to determine any 8 year old medal winners.

Times achieved will be suitable to enter county championships and level 3 open meets. They are **not** admissible for Regional or National events, level 1 & level 2 open meets.

## Club Championships' records

Club records may be gained by swimming at Club Championships and any Colchester Swimming Club Open meet.

The swimmer must submit a completed new club record application form to the club committee for validation if a new record time is swam at one of the clubs open meets.

## Special Events:

### Individual Medley Competition

This competition is for those swimmers who compete in **both** the 200m and 400m Individual Medley; there is a junior and open age group trophy.

For swimmers who compete in both events, points are allocated according to placing of each distance:

3 points = 1<sup>st</sup> place,

2 points = 2<sup>nd</sup> place,

1 point = 3<sup>rd</sup> place,

Points for both events are then totalled to give final placing for the Junior and Open age group trophy winners

## OLYMPIC CHALLENGE

The coaches invite you to enter our Olympic challenge. The start date will be from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2019 to run for one year, finishing on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020. Awards will be given out at the following year's presentation evening.

This event is aimed at Performance Plus, Performance, Potential, Young Potential, Senior Development, and Masters.

Swimmers – you must complete the following Olympic events. These may be swum at Colchester Swimming Club Championships and/or any other licensed meet. Each swim must be signed for by the attending Colchester club coach if present or event results may be presented to your coach for signature.

Successful swimmers will receive an Olympic challenge reward.
